Rules for Workshop

- 7. Network Respectfully: Use networking opportunities to build relationships in a professional and respectful manner. Avoid engaging in behaviour that may be perceived as harassment.
- 8. Gratitude: Express gratitude to the organizers, speakers, and fellow participants for their contributions to the workshop.
